Legitimacy

We have established rights according to our legitimacy in Christ Jesus

- We are citizens of Heaven (Philippians 3:20; Psalm 139:16)
- We are Ambassadors of Heaven (2 Corinthians 5:20-21)
- We are Ministers of Reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:18-19)

• We are Children [Sons] of God, bene Elohim (John 1:12-13; Hosea 1:10; Psalm 82; Luke 10:19; Jermiah 1:5; Roman 8:16-18; John 10:33-39)

- We are Heirs of God and co-Heirs with Christ (Roman 8:16-18)
- We are the Ecclesia in Heaven and on earth (Matthew 16:19)
- We are God's workmanship created in Christ Jesus (Ephesians 2:10)
- We have dominion over all living things of the earth (Genesis 1:26-28)
- We are given the mind of Christ (Mark 13:32; 1 Corinthians 2:13-16; Acts 15:28-29)

We are heavenly beings, having an earthly experience. Origin has to do with who we are.

Courts of Hell

False Judge

Shaphat (shaw-fat) H8199

avenge, that condemn, contend, defend, execute judgment, be a judgment A primitive root; to judge. Pronounce sentences (for or against); by implication, to vindicate or punish; by extension, to govern; passively, to litigate, avenge, that condemn, contend, defend, execute (judgment), plead, reason, rule.

Legal agreements look like binding ropes or handcuffs (Matthew 16:19)

Confusion is the most common fruit and favorite ingredient of false judgements (James 3:16-18)

False judgements from the Courts of Hell intersect blessings from God. A false judgment is an overstep of government authority or establishments of laws or mandates without going through the proper legal channels such as executive orders. Embracing the lie is empowering the liar.

Gates of Hell (Sheol) is also Gates of Death

• Sheol (sheh-ole') H7585 - Underworld (a place to which people descend at death); grave, hell, pit God overturned false verdicts from the Gates of Death (Psalm 107:16-20; Isaiah 45:2)

"I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My <u>church</u>; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it."I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven." -Gates of Hades shall not prevail against the <u>church</u>, Jesus is the Rock (Matthew 16:18-19)

Greek word for Church = ecclesia

Aramaic word for Church = edah

Which is the same Hebrew word edah (H5712, H5707, H5713)

• Edah (ayd) H5712

A stated assemblage (specifically a concourse or generally family or crowd); assembly, gathering, multitude, company, congregation, people, swarm.

• Ed (ayd) H5707

Testimony; witness; specially a recorder, that is, a prince

Edah (ay-daw) H5713

Testimony; witness Cloud of witnesses (Hebrews 12:1)

False judgements are stumbling blocks that:

- Bind people
- Blind People
- Confuse People
- Cause them to do wicked things
- Cause good things to be withheld
- Take life prematurely (Psalm 90:10)
- Cause strife, division and destruction
- Make people feel powerless and hopeless
- Effect the ability to love
- Remove soundness of mind

The purpose the enemy has to bind people into bondage is to keep them from fulfilling the purposes of God according to Ephesians 2:10 - *For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.*

Council of the Wicked

The encouragement to sin more and justify every sin is the fruit of false judgments "The redefinition of sin to justify our behavior is a smokescreen created by the enemy to alienate us from the love of God." -Dr Ron Horner

Courts of Heaven

God as our Judge who sits upon a fiery throne (Daniel 7:9) The Lord Most High judges among the hosts of heaven (Psalm 82) Jesus as our legal advocate or attorney (1 John 2:1) Satan is a legalist: he and all evil spirits are always looking for faults in everything that they could use to accuse us before our Judge. When the enemy does accuse us, we must go to the Court of Accusation or Mobile Court and answer the charge. Respond to the accusation by coming in agreement with the charge (Matthew 5:25) Must have a contrite spirit to utilize and operate in the courts of heaven in a place of humility. Sometimes that requires us to surrender our own authority to the Court out of respect. (Isaiah 66:2) In many cases in the court, repentance is required. (Daniel 9; 2 Peter 3:9) It's not necessary to cast out demons inside the court.

Adversary

Satan is our accuser or prosecutes us (Zech 3:1)

The devil is your adversary (1 Peter 5:8)

Antidikos (an-tid'-ee-kos) G476

An opponent at law, adversary in a lawsuit, a technical legal term used in antiquity of an adversary in a courtroom, someone seeking official (formal, binding) damages.

Brings *formal* charges as they are *binding* to *exact penalty*. *Satan* acts as such an adversary, bringing the "(law)suit" of darkness against believers for their eternal damnation.

The devil is like a lion seeking to find a legal right to operate in your life and devour you. He cannot devour you unless he has the legal right to (Luke 22:31-32)

The purpose of lawsuits is to keep you from your rights. We have rights under the New Covenant to heal, live, restore, thrive, prosper.

Satan was summoned by God to the courts of heavens (Job 1:6-12)

Once you are free from the adversary, you can move into places where you didn't before.

What's the difference between Sins, Transgressions and Iniquity?

• Sins are made by mistakes, misleading understandings, ignorance and indulging into temptation.

• Transgressions means stepping over the line that you were not meant to cross over. It is done by our own will knowing the consequences.

Iniquity is history of sin in the bloodline

The enemy gets legal right in iniquity.

Iniquity will fashion what you think about yourself (Isaiah 6:5-6)

Contracts and agreements

Spiritual contracts (Romans 6:23)

Jesus' blood nullifies our sins and imputed righteousness to us and silences our accuser.

Witnesses of contracts and agreements (Colossians 2:14)

Buying a field (Jeremiah 32:6-44)

Using Wisdom (Proverbs 8:14-16; Daniel 2:20-22)

We have responsibility to steward the Truth revealed (Luke 8:17-18; Matthew 13:12; Matthew 25:29; Mark 4:24) Any verdicts coming from the Courts of Heaven are from the higher courts than any court of hell Promises of verdicts of righteousness (Isaiah 16:5; Psalm 89:14)

Verdicts that were overturned (Psalm 33:10-11; Zephaniah 3:14-15; Psalm 140:8-10)

Example of Protocol in the Court of Accusation:

- Ask the Judge to convene the Court

- Ask for a verdict from the Judge and receive any documents you need
- Enforce the verdict
